Tax update

Taxes are filed and we're anticipating that we will be forgiven for late filing.

Bike trailer

Kaiya suggested that we try to tap into a bike rodeo or some kind of community event as opposed to doing something just at our school. There was concern about where the bikes could be used at school. Kaiya is currently recruiting a new SRTS program coordinator, as well as seeing if anyone would be interested in taking over the annual bike sale, which is a fundraiser.

Funding Requests

Everybody Wins has requested funding of \$120 to pay for 1/3 of the costs of the meal on their family/mentor/mentee literacy night. We discussed that this is something that is available to all students even though there is a limit to how many can participate (currently 21). We agreed to fund this request.

The preschool program has requested funding to support a professional development opportunity in Italy to study the Reggio Emilio approach. There are \$400 set aside for preschool enrichment (\$200 from last year and \$200 from this year). In addition, the PTA felt they could extend an additional \$200 of support, for a total of \$600. We felt it was important that there was parity in how the funds were used. We agreed to fund this request.
